Whenever Nature strikes to show her displeasure or anger, it is disastrous. It is impossible to visualise the amount of damage caused to life and property. 25 April 2015 was a Black Saturday for the citizens of Nepal as the Himalayan nation was struck by one of the worst earthquakes ever in eighty years. The quake with a magnitude of 7.8 caused unimaginable loss to life and property. In the massive earthquake thousands of people were rendered homeless as entire villages were flattened across many districts in Nepal. The rescue teams focussed on the areas surrounding historic monuments as it is feared that many may be trapped in these places. Sindhupalchok, north east of Kathmandu has been identified as one of the worst affected areas. In Kathmandu, the capital, there is a severe shortage of food and water and many people are fleeing to their native homes and villages. It is feared that the farming community which comprises almost two thirds of the country's population may be the worst affected.

Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam was born on 15 October 1931 to a Tamil Muslim family in Rameswaram, Tamil Nadu. His father owned a ferry and his mother was a housewife. He completed his schooling from Schwartz Higher Secondary School, Ramanathapuram, and went on to attend Saint Joseph's College, Thiruchirappalli, where he graduated in physics. After his graduation in Madras Institute of Technology, he joined the Aeronautic Development Establishment of the Defence Research and Development Organisation as a scientist. He was closely associated with India's civilian space program and military missile development efforts. He thus came to be known as the 'Missile Man of India' for his work on the development of ballistic missile and launch vehicle technology. As Dr. Kalam himself acknowledged, "I learnt leadership from three great teachers - Dr. Vikram Sarabhai, Prof. Satish Dhawan and Dr. Brahm Prakash." The most important aspect of Kalam's personality was his essential simplicity, his childlike enthusiasm and his modesty. He kept meeting students whenever and wherever he could. He wanted the students to question, to explore, to develop the confidence and courage to think big and achieve their goal. Dr. Kalam was the third president to receive

the Bharat Ratna. India's highest civilian honour before he became the President. He was a great thinker and writer. The most famous of his books are Wings of Fire, Ignited Minds: Unleashing the Power within India and My Journey, Transforming Dreams into Actions.

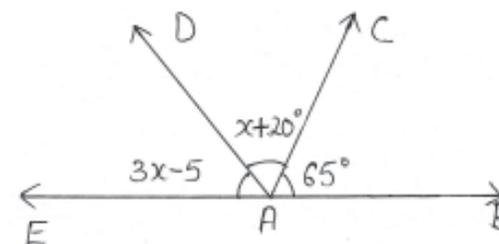

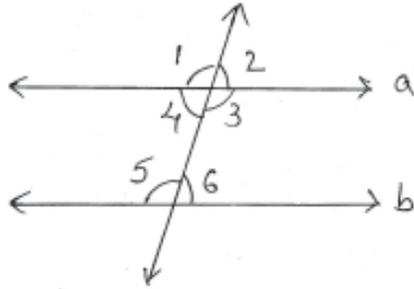

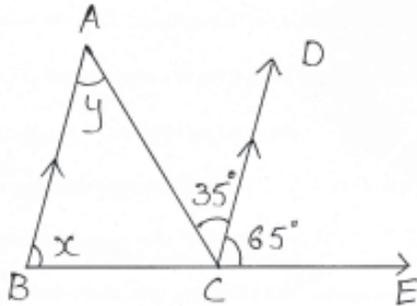
